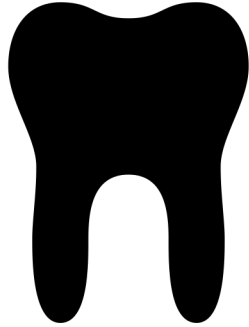

Program Overview



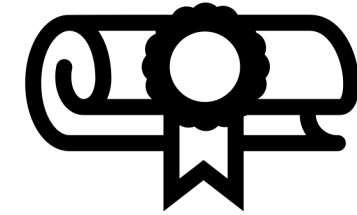
On-The-Job Training

- Customized by employer
 - No wage requirements
- No prior experience/minimum qualifications
- Each employer recruits/hires their own students
- No required coach to student ratio, suggested 1:1



Curriculum

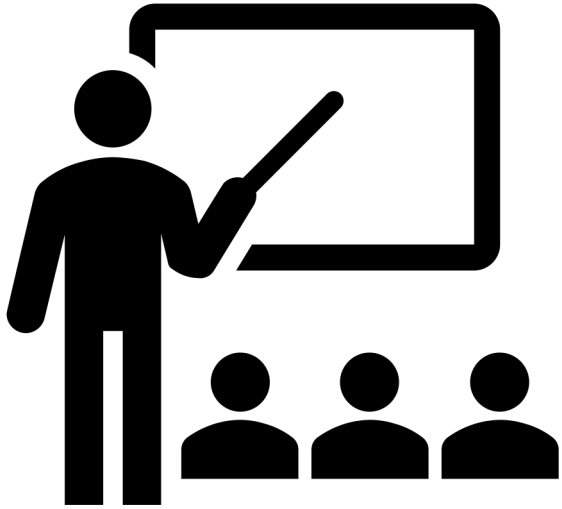
- Instructor led
- Virtual on Canvas
- Can be completed anytime/anywhere
 - Grading requirements
- Students receive Certificate of Completion



Skill Tracking

- Skill Logs provided, but optional
- Any dental staff can sign off on skill practices
- Any completed Skill Logs will be displayed on the Certificate of Completion
- Progress Reports sent once a month to clinical team

Curriculum Overview



- Virtual, asynchronous curriculum on Canvas
- 39 Modules, approximately 10 hours/week
 - Textbook reading, skill videos, short answer assessment, & module quiz
 - 5 Cumulative Quizzes, Mid Term, & Final Exam, plus quarterly extra credit
- 70% Minimum Passing Grade
 - 10% Late penalties per day

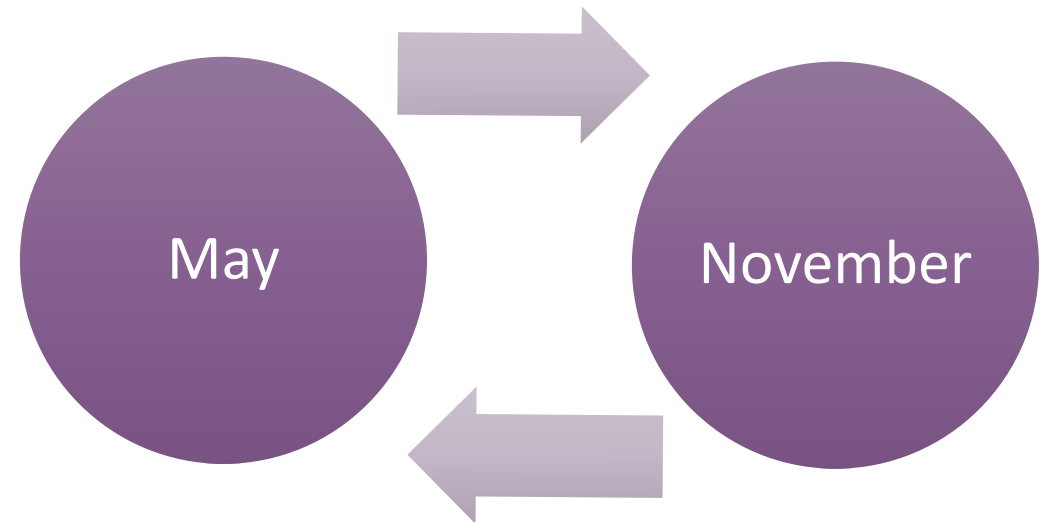
